## Guests

**Philip Yancey**, a native of Atlanta, Georgia, earned graduate degrees in Communications and English from Wheaton College Graduate School and the University of Chicago. He joined the staff of *Campus Life Magazine* in 1971, and worked there for ten years as Editor and then Publisher.

Then Philip became a full-time writer, initially working as a journalist for such varied publications as *Reader's Digest*, *Publisher's Weekly*, *National Wildlife*, *Christian Century* and *The Reformed Journal*. For many years he wrote a monthly column for *Christianity Today* magazine, which he still serves as Editor at Large.

Christian bookstore managers selected *The Jesus I Never Knew* as the 1996 Book of the Year, and *What's So Amazing About Grace?* won the same award in 1998. His most recent books are *Prayer: Does It Make Any Difference?*, *Grace Notes*, and *What Good Is God?*

The Yanceys enjoy mountain climbing, skiing, wildlife, and all the other delights of the Rocky Mountains, and also maintain a regular schedule of international trips.

**Tim Sanders** is a rare mix of business man, author and artist. He was one of Mark Cuban's first employees at broadcast.com. He was the Chief Solutions Officer and Leadership Coach at Yahoo during their hey day. His latest book, *Today We Are Rich*, is a best seller and familiar to our community. He is one of the top rated speakers on the lecture circuit, leveraging his decade of experience as a working musician. He is a Christ follower, and keynoted at both the Willow Creek simulcast and Catalyst.

**Derek Webb** started his music career over 20 years ago as a founding member of the Texas-based folk/rock band Caedmon's Call. After 10 years, Derek left to pursue a solo career that quickly garnered him a reputation for being a provocative singer/songwriter, challenging the political and

Magazine's Top 100 albums of 2007, having received a coveted 5-star review, and Derek was recently named one of Performing Songwriter magazine's 100 most influential independent artists of the past 15 years.

**Kim Hill** is a 23-year veteran of the CCM music world. She's a Grammy nominated, Dove award-winning artist with 16 cds to her credit. The past 14 years, she's primarily been leading worship at women's conferences around the country and is a perennial favorite for The Billy Graham Training Center, Focus on the Family, Max Lucado and Angela Thomas. Kim also continues to be a favorite guest worship leader at various churches around the country including Oak Hills Church (San Antonio), Hope Pres Church (Memphis) and Bent Tree Fellowship (Dallas).

**One Sonic Society** is about unity, creativity, and community. Led by Jason Ingram [vocals/guitar], Stu Garrard [guitar/vocals] and Paul Mabury [drums]; an international collective of respected artists, united in creating music to serve the Church.

**Mark Roach** Since his debut CD released in July of 2007 with Myrrh/Word Records, Mark has been doing a lot of what he'd been doing prior to signing. Leading the Arts ministry at his home church just west of St. Louis, MO. Four years later, self-produced, self-managed and independent, Mark aims to deliver an evolved collection of songs into the hands of listeners, worshipers and worship leaders. Mark's upcoming *Uncontained* EP is set for release this April. Currently in his 12th year of ministry at Morning Star Church, Mark continues to lead worship across the country and his songs are sung in churches across the world.

**Vince Marotte** Vince Marotte is an author and communicator from Austin, TX. He is the Internet Pastor at Gateway Church, a community known for taking very seriously a mentality of love first where you often hear that 'no perfect people are allowed'. In 2010 Vince wrote 'Context and Voice'; a book about communication design in a new media culture. He spends his spare time cycling, skateboarding and getting into the outdoors as much as possible.

**Melissa Greene** Since her early childhood, Melissa has pursued life and art with a passion for people, a love for music and ministry, and a gentle spirit for all who encounter her. Wife to Ben, and mother to Hutch (5) and Haven (2), Melissa's daily life also includes leading and serving and extended family and community.

After finding her musical beginnings in the group Truth whom she toured with for two years, singing back ground vocals for artists like Kirk Franklin, and a nearly 7 year ministry as a member of the award-winning group Avalon, Melissa continues her pursuit of truth, God's heart, and her desire to be an example in excellence in her artistry, as the full time Pastor of Worship and Arts at GracePointe church in Franklin, TN.

When she's not busy caring for her family, and those in her growing church community, she spends time traveling to other churches and organizations speaking, leading worship, doing solo concerts, and sharing her heart and vision for where she feels God is leading her. As her life unfolds, Melissa hopes to continue to seek truth with an open mind, love with an intentional heart, and to savor every experience that comes her way.

**Susan Fontaine Godwin** MS Education, is an educator and long-time member of the Christian Arts community with 27 years of experience in the media industry, music publishing, and church copyright administration. Her mission is to help Christians become fully copyright compliant through online administration, consultation and education. Her passion is to build online bridges between copyright owners and users of their content. She presents seminars worldwide and has written three books on copyrights, publishing and creative planning. She is affectionately known as the "Copyright Queen."

**Starfield** Canadian worship band, Starfield, has spent the last 10 years partnering with churches and ministries, leading students and congregations in passionate and energetic worship. Starfield-penned songs like "Filled With Your Glory", "Reign In Us", and "The Saving One" are sung in church services every weekend all over the world. Starfield is the most-awarded and top-selling Christian band in Canada, and are expanding that following in the US, United Kingdom, and Europe with yearly concert tours and conference appearances. Ministry partnerships with the Billy Graham Association, Dare2Share, and Youth Specialties have helped Starfield grow beyond the confines of the music industry and more directly into partnerships with the local Church.

**Andy Cherry** 25 year old songwriter and worship leader Andy Cherry hails from Charlotte, N.C. Sonically, his thoughtful, complex arrangements stitch together the warmth of American roots music with soaring, moody tones of British rock. Lyrically, Cherry challenges commonly held assumptions about God, urging listeners to open up, be bold enough to ask God the tough questions, and believe that He has the shoulders to bear those questions.

**Carlton Dillard** Carlton Dillard joined the staff of Riverbend Church in Austin, Texas as Pastor of Creative Arts in 1989. He is known across the country for his innovative use of all styles of music in the church setting. He is in much demand as a conference speaker and clinician and is also proficient as a singer, songwriter, arranger and producer with songs and arrangements currently being used by churches across the US. Dillard's vast musically diverse background allows him to program material that appeals to all ages and tastes. Carlton is married to Sharon and has 4 children, Heath, Heather, Jamie and Jessica and four grandchildren Maya, Reagan, Serena and Jonah.

**Mike Lewis** has been painting at Christian events since mid 1998. He paints large portraits of Christ in under twenty minutes. It began when his close friend, Christian songwriter Seth Haines, told him that he had written a song called "Intimate Portrait" and wanted Mike to paint a portrait of Christ on stage during the song. Although Mike was in art school, he had never really painted before. The request was actually rather unreasonable in terms of possibility. Seth wanted a portrait large enough for an entire audience to see and also a likeness to Christ painted in seven minutes. Artists will tell you that usually portraits are very time consuming and some spend years on a single piece. Intimidated by the request but challenged by God Mike decided to trust him and began planning for the painting.

After several months of thought and preparation the night arrived. Mike did not have the available funds to do a practice painting so the first try was live on stage. After a short prayer with his friend Mark Herrera that whatever happened God would be glorified through the artwork he walked to the stage and began to paint. Mike says that immediately everything disappeared except the canvas. He has described it as his most peaceful personal time with Christ. He began to swirl colors from the

entire spectrum into the face of Christ, then at the end of the painting when the face was recognizable he began to throw blood (red paint) right in Jesus' face. This can be painful to watch but we need to realize that we are responsible for the blood that he shed.

Many people were in the crowd who wanted Mike to come paint for a youth group or church service, the rest as they say "was history". Now there are eleven different compositions that Mike has developed, four of which are available to the public. He now paints and speaks on a regular basis. A new ministry is born. Glory to God!

**Donnie Haulk** As President/CEO of AE Global Media he and his team develop campus wide technology systems for businesses and ministries worldwide. Donnie and his team have designed and installed thousands of production media systems around the world, along with producing thousands of live events. Over 2 million people experience live production & worship on systems they have designed and installed every week with millions more tuning in via customized broad casting and web-casting technologies. Donnie is a pioneer in performance acoustics and media technologies. He continues to pursue excellence in design and implementation.

Developing ways to inspire people through innovative design, using technology and automation to create environments that communicate is his passion.

**Warren Barfield** At eighteen Warren Barfield used his dorm room as an office and booked one year of concerts. With his parents' blessing he loaded his 1995, 4 cylinder, mint green Mustang with a suitcase and a guitar and took his songs on the road. After more than 600 "gigs" and 200,000 miles, Warren found himself in Nashville, TN signing his first record deal. Since his arrival in Nashville, he has released three records, had five songs top the Christian charts, received two Dove nominations, worked with legendary producers including Brown Bannister, Mark Hammond, Marshall Altman, Charlie Peacock, and Mark Miller.

He's shared the stage with the best of CCM artists from Steven Curtis Chapman and Third Day to Toby Mac. He wrote and recorded "Love is Not a Fight" which was the theme song for the #1 indie film FIREPROOF. He shares his songs and stories with thousands every year as he tours the country. Warren currently lives in Nashville, TN with his wife Megan and their son Montgomery. Warren's description of his journey goes like this, "I have seen every dream I had as a fifteen year old in Spivey's Corner, NC come true." [warrenbarfield.com](http://warrenbarfield.com)

**Leeland** Hailing from Houston, GRAMMY-nominated progressive rock act Leeland comprises Leeland Mooring (lead vocals, guitar); Jack Mooring (keyboard, background vocals); Shelly Mooring (bass); and Mike Smith (drums). The group has been known to deliver songwriting beyond its years and worshipful rock so genuine it disarms the honest cynic. Often quoted as one of Christian music's most gripping live bands, Leeland's 2006 debut *Sound of Melodies* as well as follow up projects *Opposite Way* (2008), *Love Is On The Move* (2010) and recent release *The Great Awakening* (2011), have established Leeland as a leader in the worship community and beyond. All four albums have been GRAMMY nominated and drew a combined eight GMA Dove Award nominations.

In February, Leeland and Jack Mooring were selected by the White House to participate in the Compassion in Action Roundtable spotlighting the innovative leadership of an emerging generation of social entrepreneurs in America. On top of non-stop touring across the U.S., Europe and Japan, the band also partners with Christian relief organization Food for the Hungry.

**Logan Martin** In 2002 Logan Martin picked up a guitar and began writing and performing his original music in churches, bars, and coffee shops throughout the West Coast. He has opened for and toured with such artists as Phil Wickham, Shawn McDonald, Jason Gray, and Warren Barfield. Logan released his first full-length record “Colorless” in 2007, which garnered high praise from CCM Magazine, saying, “Logan Martin has created a truly enjoyable debut album...one that you don't want to miss!” He has since continued to create music and lead people in worship all over the world, releasing two more albums as well as joining forces with Food For the Hungry two years ago. His songwriting stems from his own honest (sometimes awkward) journey with Jesus, as well as the worship he sees (and hopes to see soon) inside the church. **My Anchor Holds (Jacob & Katie Ekeberger)** Katie and Jacob grew up on music in separate parts of the country. The mid west brought out the Blues & Soul in Katie while the south turned Jacob onto an Americana-folk sound. Both Katie and Jacob ended up at Greenville College in southern IL. They connected over music and soon fell in love. Now married for almost 6 years, Katie and Jacob travel as “My Anchor Holds” leading worship and performing concerts across the US. Their “Americana-Soul” music stems from a deep respect for the hymns of the church and honest conversations about faith, genuine love, and truly limitless grace. <http://www.myanchorholds.net/>

**Elevation Worship** Elevation Church, based in Charlotte, NC, began with 16 people and one massive vision to reach out to people far from God. In just 5 years, Elevation Church is considered the fastest-growing church in America with more than 10,000 in weekly attendance. The Elevation Worship team, led by Worship Pastors Wade Joye, Matt Brock, Chris Brown, and London Gatch, eventually began to write and record songs that reflected their congregations' journey, experiences, and needs.

The fourth and latest release from Elevation Worship entitled *For The Honor*, features all new songs including the title track, “All Things New”, “Exalted One”, and “The Church”. As with recent movements such as Hillsong, Passion, & Jesus Culture, when worship music is dynamic, authentic, and holds nothing back, God blesses it and lives are changed. Elevation Worship seeks to connect with other worship leaders and churches to unite resources, gifts, and ideas to better serve God and the Church through worship.

**Julie Arnold** is the Multi Campus Service Programming Director at North Point Ministries, Inc. She currently facilitates the programming at their five campuses and facilitates their media and production divisions. The church has over 15,000 attendees each Sunday. Julie has received her BFA from University of Georgia in acting and directing which has served her well in creating the live worship experience. She has been married to Edsel for 30 years and they have three children they have adopted from Vietnam, Cole – 13 years, Eleanor and Lillian – 10 years.

**Andy Wilson** is VP Product Marketing Management at Cinsay.com where he defines and refines product features driven by customer needs. A product development and technology executive with extensive start-up experience, Andy has launched B2B and B2C websites for ecommerce, cloud computing, group collaboration, and video and audio conferencing. Andy served as Chief Marketing Officer and General Manager at Durable Data Corporation, a cloud data services provider. In 2007 he co-founded OpenACircle.com, a website providing collaborative data services company.
